PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Department of Regulation and Licensing. The Secretary has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Secretary in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. David A. Schneider ("Respondent") was born on February 28, 1945, and is licensed as a registered substance abuse counselor in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 12350-131. This license was first granted on September 21, 2001.

2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing is 26802 Long Lake Road, Wind Lake, Wisconsin 53185.

3. On December 3, 2010, Respondent plead no contest and was convicted of fourth degree sexual assault in Milwaukee County Circuit Court, following an incident in which he had inappropriate contact with a client.

4. Respondent has tendered surrender of his license, asserting that a consequence of surgery in October 2001 to remove a tumor from his brain was impairment of impulse control, creating a disability to practice, which was likely the cause of his inappropriate contact with his client.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. §440.88, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. The conduct described in paragraph #3, above, constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code § RL 164.01(2).

ORDER


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
