The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Architect Section (Section) of the Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors. The Section has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Section in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Terrence W. Martin is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as an Architect, having license # 05-4690. This license was first granted to him on April 27, 1979, was expired from May 4, 2006 through July 9, 2009, and is current through July 31, 2012. The most recent

address on file with the Department of Regulation and Licensing for Mr. Martin is 117 E. Fulton St., Waupaca, WI 54981.

2. On or about April 7, 2009, the Department received a complaint regarding a project for which Mr. Martin was the architect.
3. During the course of the investigation, the Department Investigator discovered that Mr. Martin's license had been expired since May 4, 2006, and that Mr. Martin was at that time unable to renew his license due to tax delinquency.
4. After the Department Investigator contacted Mr. Martin regarding the complaint and discussed the status of his license, Mr. Martin contacted the Department of Revenue to address the tax delinquency issue. As a result, Mr. Martin was able to renew his license on July 9, 2009.
5. During the period of time that his license was expired, Mr. Martin worked as an architect on the following projects: Zawislan 6-unit Apartment Building (2006-2007); Schricker 2-unit Apartment Building (2006-2007); Crystal Lake Methodist Church Addition (2007); Twisted Tom's Restaurant Addition and Remodel (2008-2009); Clearwater Harbor Restaurant Addition (2009); and Rhone Storage Building (2009).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Architect Section of the Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Land Surveyors has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 443.11, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
2. Respondent Terrence W. Martin has violated Wis. Stat. § 443.02(2) by practicing architecture while his license was expired as described in paragraphs 3-5 of the Findings of Fact.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Respondent Terrence W. Martin (architect certificate of registration # 05-4690) is hereby **REPRIMANDED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

2. Respondent Terrence W. Martin shall, within 120 days of the date of this Order, pay **COSTS** of this matter in the amount of **SEVEN HUNDRED AND TEN DOLLARS (\$710.00)**.
3. Payment of costs (made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing) shall be mailed or delivered by the Respondent to the Department Monitor at this address:

4. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Section in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the costs as set forth above, the Respondent's license (#05-4690) may, in the discretion of the Section or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the costs.
5. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
