The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing ("Department"). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Patrick T. Krieser (dob 10/06/1961) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Private Security Person, having license number 108-22718, first issued on 01/07/2003 and current through 08/31/2012. Mr. Krieser's most recent address on file with the Department is 1621 South 90th Street, Apt. 1, West Allis, WI 53214.

2. On or about July 6, 2010, Mr. Krieser submitted a renewal application to the Department.

3. A Criminal Information Bureau check revealed a conviction for Mr. Krieser within the two years preceding July 6, 2010. The Department subsequently opened this case for investigation.

4. Court records obtained during the course of the Department's investigation revealed that on or about June 28, 2010, Mr. Krieser was convicted of Operating While under Influence (2nd).

5. Mr. Krieser failed to notify the Department of the conviction within 48 hours after the entry of the judgment of conviction.

6. In resolution of this matter, Respondent Patrick T. Krieser consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The State of Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in paragraph 4 of the Findings of Fact, Respondent Patrick T. Krieser has violated Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(2) by violating a law which substantially relates to the practice of a private security person.

3. By the conduct described in paragraph 5 of the Findings of Fact, Respondent Patrick T. Krieser has violated Wis. Stat. § 440.26(4m)(b) and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(2) by failing to report his conviction to the department within 48 hours of the judgment of conviction.

4. As a result of the violations noted in the Conclusions of Law, Respondent Patrick T. Krieser is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a) and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Respondent Patrick T. Krieser (license number 108-22718) is hereby REPRIMANDED.

2. Within ninety (90) days following the date of this Order, Respondent Patrick T. Krieser shall pay COSTS in the amount of TWO HUNDRED SIXTY DOLLARS (\$260.00).


3. Payment of the costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

4. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent Patrick T. Krieser fails to timely submit payment of the costs as ordered and as set forth above, Respondent Krieser's license (number 108-22718) may, in the discretion of the Department or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the costs.

5. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
