The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Julie A. Hall, date of birth: 09/17/66, is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology Manager, license number 81-23846. This license was first granted to her on 06/11/1990 and is current through 03/31/2011.

2. The most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing (Department) for Respondent Hall is 23950 1st Avenue South, Siren, WI 54872.

3. Respondent Mane Attractions is duly licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology Establishment, license number 80-37370. This license was first granted to Mane Attractions on 02/08/2010 and is current through 03/31/2011.

4. The most recent address on file with the Department for Respondent Mane Attractions is 23950 1st Avenue, Siren, WI 54872.

5. Mane Attractions, barbering and cosmetology establishment license number 80-26230, was located at 7708 West Main Street, Siren, WI 54872. This license was first granted on 02/14/1997 and it expired on 06/30/2007.

6. Respondent Hall is the manager responsible for Respondent Mane Attractions. As a duly licensed barbering and cosmetology manager, at all times relevant to this action, Respondent Hall was and is responsible for compliance with Wisconsin Statutes, Chapter 454 and the Wisconsin Administrative Code for Barbering and Cosmetology, Chapters 2 and 3.

7. From July 2007 through September 2007, the Department received three complaints alleging fraudulent activity and unlicensed practice was taking place at the former Mane Attractions establishment. The complaint was subsequently opened for investigation.

8. The Department's investigation revealed that Shannyn Russell (license number 82-72682) began working at Mane Attractions in Siren, Wisconsin at a date unknown, but prior to June 30, 2005. Ms. Russell practiced barbering and cosmetology at Mane Attractions until sometime in 2009. Ms. Russell's practitioner license expired July 8, 2005 and was not renewed until January 14, 2010.

9. The Department's investigation also revealed that the license for Mane Attractions, number 80-26230, expired on June 30, 2007 and Mane Attractions operated in expired status until October 2009 when the establishment moved to 23950 1st Avenue, Siren, WI 54872. Mane Attractions immediately began operation at that location but failed to get an establishment license for the new location until February 8, 2010.

10. The Department's investigation further revealed that on May 15, 2007, Julie A. Hall signed an Employment Verification certifying Sara J. Kielpikowski's (now Bukachek) employment at Mane Attractions, under Hall's supervision from March 1, 2005 through May 5, 2007, for a total of 4,060 hours. Respondent Hall admitted that Sara J. Bukachek did not complete 4,060 hours employment at Mane Attractions or under her supervision as a manager.

11. In resolution of this matter, Respondents Julie A. Hall and Mane Attractions consent to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in paragraph eight (8) of the Findings of Fact, Respondents Julie A. Hall and Mane Attractions have violated Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.04(1) by assisting in the unlicensed practice of barbering and cosmetology by Shannyn Russell.

3. By the conduct described in paragraph nine (9) of the Findings of Fact, Respondents Julie A. Hall and Mane Attractions have violated Wis. Stat. § 454.08(1)(b), Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.045(1), Wis. Admin. Code § BC 3.01(1), and Wis. Admin. Code § BC 3.06(2) practicing barbering and cosmetology outside of a licensed establishment.

4. By the conduct described in paragraph ten (10) of the Findings of Fact, Respondent Julie A. Hall has violated Wis. Stat. § 454.15(2)(a), (c), and (i) by aiding Sara Bukachek in fraudulently obtaining her barbering and cosmetology manager's license.

5. As a result of the violation noted in the Conclusions of Law, Respondents Julie A. Hall and Mane Attractions are subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15(2)(i).

#### <u>ORDER</u>

#### NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Respondents Julie A. Hall and Mane Attractions be, and hereby are, **REPRIMANDED**.

#### IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

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2. Respondent Julie A. Hall shall pay COSTS in the amount of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$150.00) within 90 days of the date of this Order.

3. Respondent Julie A. Hall shall pay a FORFEITURE in the amount of TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,0000). Four payments of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) shall be submitted every 90 days from the date of this order until the full TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS is paid in full.

4. Payment of the costs and forfeiture shall be made to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing and sent to:

Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondents' licenses. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondents fail to timely submit payment of the costs and forfeiture as ordered and as set forth above, then Respondents' licenses (numbers 81-23846 and 80-37370) may, in the discretion of the board or its designee, be **SUSPENDED**, without further notice or hearing, until Respondents have complied with payment of costs and forfeiture.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
