The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent D'Pelos Barber Shop (D'Pelos) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology Establishment, having license number 80-36745, first issued on 04/13/09 and current through 03/31/11. D'Pelos' most recent address on file with the Wisconsin

Department of Regulation and Licensing (Department) is 3462 S. 13th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53215.

- 2. Respondent Gerardo Hernandez is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Barbering and Cosmetology Practitioner, having license number 82-87237, first issued on 05/14/07 and current through 03/31/13. Hernandez's most recent address on file with the Department is 3479 S. 12th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53215.
- 3. Respondent Hernandez is the owner of Respondent D'Pelos. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.06, as owner, Hernandez was at all times relevant to this matter responsible for compliance with Wis. Stat. Ch. 454 and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2, 3 and 4.
- 4. On December 7, 2009, the Department received a complaint against Respondents alleging failure to employ a full time manager and participation in the unauthorized or unlicensed practice of barbering and cosmetology.
- 5. On March 25, 2010, a Division of Enforcement investigator inspected D'Pelos and observed the following:
 - a. There was no full time licensed manager having direct authority over the operations of the establishment;
 - b. There were copious amounts of loose hair on the salon floor;
 - c. There was loose hair in workstation drawers used for storing clean implements;
 - d. There were hair clippings on the outside of the wax pot utilized for waxing services;
 - e. There were hair clippings on stored razor attachments;
 - f. Clean implements were stored in uncovered containers; and
 - g. Disinfectant was not changed on a daily basis.
- 6. In resolution of this matter, Respondents consent to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
 - 2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondents violated:

- a. Wis. Stat. § 454.08(6) and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.06(5) and 3.02(1) by operating Respondent D'Pelos without a full time licensed manager having direct authority over the operations of the establishment;
- b. Wis. Admin. Code § BC 3.01(4) by failing to keep all floor coverings in an establishment in a clean, orderly and safe condition;
- c. Wis. Admin. Code § BC 4.01(1) by failing to maintain all areas of an establishment and the equipment, tools and implements used by licensees for services in an establishment in a clean, sanitary and safe condition;
- d. Wis. Admin. Code § BC 4.02(4) by failing to place clean and disinfected contact equipment in covered containers; and
- e. Wis. Admin. Code § BC 4.02(5) by failing to change disinfectant on a daily basis.
- 3. As a result of the above violations, Respondents are subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 454.15(2)(c) and (i) and 454.15(3).

<u>ORDER</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.
- 2. Respondents D'Pelos and Hernandez are hereby REPRIMANDED.
- 3. Respondent D'Pelos shall, within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order, pay a FORFEITURE in the amount of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) and COSTS of this matter in the amount of ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$172.50).
- 4. Respondent Hernandez shall pay a FORFEITURE in the amount of ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,200.00) and COSTS of this matter in the amount of ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$172.50).
- 5. Respondent Hernandez shall submit a down payment of SIXTY THREE DOLLARS AND SEVENTY FIVE CENTS (\$63.75) within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order. Three (3) payments of FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY SIX DOLLARS AND TWENTY FIVE CENTS (\$436.25) will be due every thirty (30) days from the date of the previous payment until the full ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$1,372.50) is paid in full.
- 6. Payment of forfeiture and costs (made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing) shall be mailed, faxed or delivered by Respondent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

- 7. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in summary suspensions of Respondents' licenses. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondents fail to timely submit payment of the forfeiture and costs as ordered, Respondents' licenses (80-36745 and 82-87237) may, in the discretion of the Board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondents have complied with payment of the forfeiture and costs.
 - 8. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
