ORDER

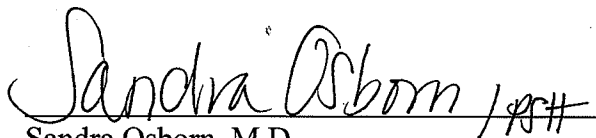

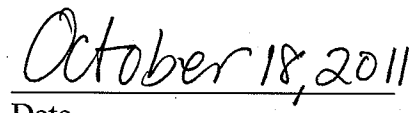
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all limitations and encumbrances upon Neal A. Melby's license are hereby removed.
