PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board. The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Mohammed R. Sethi, MD, Respondent, date of birth December 30, 1945, is licensed and currently registered by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 19311-020, which was first granted April 25, 1975 and which remains current and in good standing through October 31, 2011.

2. Respondent's address of record with the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board is P.O. Box 11943, Shorewood, WI 53211.

3. Respondent practices in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.
4. The Division has received allegations of deficiencies in Respondent's practice of prescribing controlled substances for chronic pain, and irregularities in Respondent's practice management.
5. Respondent neither admits nor denies the allegations and they are, at this point, unproven.
6. Respondent has retired from the practice of medicine due to medical reasons.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3) and authority to enter into this stipulated resolution of this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the attached Stipulation of the parties is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mohammed Sethi will not engage in the practice of medicine and will not reapply for registration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin at any time in the future and that the Department of Safety and Professional Services will not process any application for renewal of the registration of Mohammed Sethi, M.D., from the date of this Order.
