PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. David B. Hammond, R.N., (D.O.B. 09/13/1953) is licensed as a professional nurse in the State of Wisconsin (license # 30-126430). This license was first granted on July 2, 1997.

2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 3625 Duval Road Apt 813, Austin, TX 78759-3450.

3. On August 30, 1995, the Kansas State Board of Nursing issued a Consent Agreement and Final Order disciplining Respondent for failure to administer a one-time dose of Demerol intramuscular injection for a patient pursuant to physician's order, and failure to notify the physician or anyone else of his decision not to administer the medication. Respondent was ordered to obtain six hours of continuing education in the area of nursing and the law and/or nursing scope of practice.

4. On July 15, 1999, the Kansas State Board of Nursing approved a Consent Agreement with Respondent in which Respondent agreed not to practice nursing in the State of Kansas during a four-year period from September 30, 1997 through September 30, 2001.

5. On September 27, 2010, the Texas Board of Nursing issued an Agreed Eligibility Order after Respondent failed to disclose his prior discipline in the State of Kansas on his Endorsement Application to the Texas Board of Nursing. Respondent was granted a license to practice nursing in the State of Texas, but was ordered to complete education in the area of Texas nursing jurisprudence and ethics, and to pay a monetary fine of \$250.

6. Respondent currently maintains a current license in the State of Texas.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. The conduct described in paragraph 3 above constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code § N 7.04(7) and subjects Respondent to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07(1)(d).

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED:

1. David B. Hammond, R.N., Respondent, is hereby REPRIMANDED for the above conduct.

2. Respondent shall within 90 days of this Order pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of three hundred (\$300.00) dollars. Payment shall be made to the Wisconsin Department of Regulation and Licensing, and mailed to:
