On the basis of the sworn Petition for Summary Suspension and the testimony of Sherrie Johnson, investigator for the Division of Enforcement, Department of Safety and Professional Services, at the meeting of the Massage Therapy and Bodywork Therapy Affiliated Credentialing Board on August 26, 2011, the Board finds:

- That the Notice of the Petition for Summary Suspension was served on Respondent by mailing a copy of the Notice and Petition to Joao L. Frasier at 6320 Monona Drive, #104, Monona, WI 53716, on August 23, 2011; and by electronic mail transmission on August 22, 2011, to the address on file with the Department, joao\_frasier@yahoo.com.
- 2. Wisconsin Admin. Code § RL 94.01(10) defines unprofessional conduct by a massage therapist to include failure to provide draping and treatment that ensure safety and privacy to a client.
- 3. Wisconsin Admin. Code § RL 94.01(11) defines unprofessional conduct by a massage therapist to include engaging in inappropriate sexual conduct, exposure or gratification, or other sexual behavior with or in the presence of a client.
- 4. That there is probable cause to believe that Respondent engaged in unprofessional conduct with Client J.L. on April 15, 2011, by exposing the client's buttocks area,

pulling down the client's underwear, and stating that "if you rub a woman client's vagina area, you gain her trust".

- 5. That there is probable cause to believe that Respondent engaged in prohibited sexual conduct with Client B.E. on July 27, 2011, by massaging the client's chest area against her wishes, touching the client's vulva, and inserting his fingers into the client's vagina.
- 6. That Respondent's repeated inappropriate conduct exposes his clients to the unacceptable risk of sexual assault and imperatively requires the emergency suspension of Respondent's license to protect public health, safety and welfare.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 460.14 and Wis. Admin. Code ch. RL 6, that the license previously granted to Joao L. Frasier is SUMMARILY SUSPENDED, effectively immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the suspension shall continue in effect until the effective date of a final decision and order in the disciplinary proceedings against Respondent to be filed within ten days of this Order, unless otherwise ordered by the Massage Therapy and Bodywork Therapy Affiliated Credentialing Board or the Administrative Law Judge of the Department of Administration, Division of Hearings and Appeals, on behalf of the Board.

RESPONDENT IS HEREBY NOTIFIED that he has the right to demand a hearing to show cause why the summary suspension should not be continued; that hearing to be held within twenty days of receipt of Respondent's request for a hearing, unless a later time is requested or agreed to by Respondent.
