The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Department of Safety and Professional Services. The Secretary has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Penny L. Landvogt (“Respondent”) practices psychotherapy at a clinic she owns called Associates Penny L. Landvogt, Ph.D., LLC, located at 301 E. Russell Road, Janesville, Wisconsin.

2. Respondent holds no license that would entitle her to practice psychotherapy in Wisconsin.

3. Respondent was granted an opportunity to provide psychotherapy services in a State certified outpatient mental health clinic. Respondent may not provide psychotherapy services in a non-certified clinic setting or private practice.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction in this matter and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and issue this Administrative Injunction as a special order pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.21 and Wis. Admin. Code Ch. RL 3.

2. Practicing psychotherapy without a license, in a clinic not certified by the Department of Health Services or any other State entity, is prohibited under Wis. Stat. §§ 457.04(7) and 457.02(6)(b)2.

ORDER


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the attached stipulation is accepted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that unless and until Respondent is properly credentialed or her clinic is properly certified by the Department of Health Services, Respondent is enjoined and prohibited from the practice of psychotherapy in the State of Wisconsin. Violation of this special order may result in a forfeiture of up to \$10,000 for each day of violation. See Wis. Stat. § 440.21(4)(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if the Secretary determines that there is probable cause to believe that Respondent has violated any terms of this Administrative Injunction, the Secretary may order that the violations covered by this decision and order be referred to any appropriate prosecutorial unit for review for possible criminal charges.
