The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Johanna C. Edwards, R.N., (DOB 12/03/1956) is licensed as a professional nurse in the State of Wisconsin (license no. 171077-30). This license was first granted on January 15, 2010.

2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 8460 Spring Brook Road, Rockford, IL 61114.

3. On April 8, 2011, the State of Illinois, Department of Financial and Professional Regulation issued a Consent Order in which Respondent's Registered Nurse License (no. 041340743) was reprimanded. The reprimand was based on Respondent's plea to a Retail Theft Misdemeanor.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. The conduct described in paragraph 3 above constitutes a violation of Wisconsin Administrative Code § N 7.04(7) and subjects Respondent to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.01(1)(d).

ORDER

1. The SURRENDER of the license of Johanna C. Edwards, R.N. to practice nursing in the State of Wisconsin is hereby accepted.

2. The SURRENDER of the privilege of Johanna C. Edwards, R.N. to practice nursing in the State of Wisconsin under another state license pursuant to the Nurse Licensure Compact is hereby accepted.

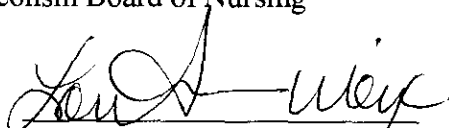
