The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Louise H. Jetzer, R.N., (DOB 03/13/1951) is licensed as a professional nurse in the State of Wisconsin (license no. 88387-30). This license was first granted on August 21, 1984.
2. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Board of Nursing is 3212 N. 21<sup>st</sup> Street, Sheboygan, WI 53083.

3. At all times relevant, Respondent was employed as a registered nurse at Aurora Sheboygan Memorial Medical Center in Sheboygan, Wisconsin.

4. Between March 31, 2009 and March 8, 2010, Respondent suffered from memory lapses and health problems which impacted her ability to work safely as a nurse.

5. Respondent is no longer actively practicing as a nurse.

6. While the Respondent denies that she suffers from a cognitive disability, she agrees that these facts are legally sufficient to support the Conclusions of Law and wishes to retire and surrender her nursing license.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. The conduct described above constitutes negligence as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § N 7.03(1)(b) and subjects Respondent to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07(1)(c).

#### ORDER

##### IT IS ORDERED:

1. The SURRENDER of the license of Louise H. Jetzer to practice nursing in the State of Wisconsin is hereby accepted.

2. The SURRENDER of the privilege of Louise H. Jetzer to practice nursing in the State of Wisconsin under another state license pursuant to the Nurse Licensure Compact is hereby accepted.

3. In the event that Respondent ever reapplies for any credential in Wisconsin Respondent shall, prior to such application, pay costs of this proceeding in the amount of six hundred dollars (\$600.00).
