PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final decision of this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board. The Board has reviewed the attached Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Frank E. Burkett, M.D., Respondent, date of birth August 21, 1947, is licensed and currently registered by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin pursuant to license number 45040-20. Respondent's license was first granted October 9, 2002 and will expire on October 31, 2011.

2. Respondent's last address reported to the Department of Safety and Professional Services is 7332 Ridgeview Court, Minocqua, WI 54548-9163.

3. Respondent's practice specialty listed with the Department is General Surgery.

4. In December 2009, Respondent requested a leave of absence from Langlade Memorial Hospital after suffering from hand neuropathy as a result of chemotherapy treatments.

5. Respondent has not practiced medicine since December 2009, and does not intend to practice in the future for medical and personal reasons.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Order, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the stipulation of the parties be approved.

2. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Frank E. Burkett, M.D. will not reapply for licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin at any time in the future and the Department of Safety and Professional Services will not process any application for renewal of his license from the date of this Order.
