The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Sigma Security Services, LLC is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Private Detective Agency, having license number 62-16694, first issued on 07/15/2009 and current through 08/31/2011. Respondent's most recent address known to the Department is 19150 South Kedzie Avenue #201, Flossmoor, IL 60422.

2. On May 5, 2011 a complaint was filed with the Department alleging that Respondent had hired and paid employees to work as private security persons without licenses.

3. An investigation revealed that Respondent had hired and paid nine (9) employees to work as private security persons without licenses for various terms beginning in November 2010 and concluding in July 2011.

4. Respondent failed to notify the Department of the hiring and termination of at least thirty (30) employees working for Respondent as private security persons between November 2010 and August 2011.

5. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a)(2) and (4) , and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5)

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent engaged in conduct which reflects adversely on his professional qualifications pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(13) by assigning employees to perform security personnel duties who were not licensed by the Department.

3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Wis. Admin. Code § RL 32.06(2) by failing to timely notify the Department of the hiring and termination of private security persons.

4. As a result of the violations noted in the Conclusions of Law, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a)(4), and Wis. Admin. Code § RL 35.01(13).

#### ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Respondent Sigma Security Services, LLC (license number 62-16694) is hereby REPRIMANDED.

2. Within 90 days of the date of this Order, Sigma Security Services, LLC shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of ONE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FORTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$1,242.00).

4. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the costs as ordered and as set forth above, Respondent's license (number 62-16694) may, in the discretion of the Department, be SUSPENDED, without further notice of hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the costs.

5. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
