The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Gabriela Quist (dob 07/07/1973) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a barbering or cosmetology manager, having license number 30494-81, first issued on 05/02/2005 and current through 03/31/2013. Respondent's most recent address on file with the

Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 1800 W. Grange Ave., Milwaukee, WI 53221. Respondent Quist is the owner of Respondent Monas Hair Salon.

2. Respondent Monas Hair Salon is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a barber or cosmetologist establishment, having license number 32676-80, first issued on 01/07/2005 and current through 03/31/2013. The license was expired between 3/31/11 and 4/26/11. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department is 606 W. Lincoln Ave, Milwaukee, WI 53215.

3. An inspection of Respondent Monas Hair Salon was performed on April 13, 2011. The establishment license had expired March 31, 2011.

4. Monas Hair Salon operates out of two locations in the building with addresses of 606 and 612 W. Lincoln Ave. Only the 606 W. Lincoln Ave. location had ever had an establishment license granted.

5. At the time of the inspection, Respondent Quist was practicing barbering or cosmetology out of both locations; neither location had a valid establishment license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondents violated Wis. Stat. § 454.08(1)(b) and Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.045(1) and BC 3.01(1) by practicing barbering or cosmetology in an establishment that had an expired license and one that never had a valid license.

3. As a result of the above violations, Respondents are subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15(2)(i).

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The attached Stipulation is hereby accepted.
2. Respondents Gabriela Quist and Monas Hair Salon are hereby REPRIMANDED.
3. Within 90 days of the date of this Order, Gabriela Quist shall pay a FORFEITURE in the amount of \$500 and COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$207. Within 90 days of the date of this Order, Monas Hair Salon shall pay a FORFEITURE in the amount of \$500 and COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$207.

4. Payment of forfeiture and costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondents' licenses. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondents fail to timely submit payment of the forfeiture and costs as ordered, Respondents' licenses (no. 32676-80 and 30494-81) may, in the discretion of the Board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondents have complied with payment of the forfeiture and costs.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
