By Final Decision and Order dated January 23, 2007, Corey R. Tielens (Applicant) was granted a Limited License to practice as a real estate salesperson. The Order permitted the Applicant to practice as a real estate salesperson under the limitations, terms and conditions outlined in the Order.

On July 12, 2012, the Applicant requested that the Real Estate Examining Board (Board) consider a petition to remove the limitations upon his license and grant him a full, unrestricted license. The Board considered the request at their August 16, 2012 meeting. After review and consideration of this matter, the Board found that limitations upon the Applicant's license continue to be necessary to ensure that the Applicant is able to practice real estate in a safe and competent manner, and to promote and protect the public interest.

The basis of this decision is made, in part, upon the finding that since being licensed in 2007, the Applicant has only practiced as a real estate salesperson for approximately one year and further, that Applicant has not consistently demonstrated practice in compliance with the terms and conditions of the 2007 Order.
