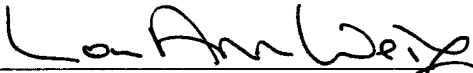
On June 7, 2012, the Department Monitor presented to the Board of Nursing for consideration of a violation of the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated March 3, 2000. Angela Hanaman was granted a stay of suspension on June 16, 2011, which was continuous provided she complied with the terms and conditions of the Order dated March 3, 2000. Based upon the information of record which shows three positive drug screens, an admission to Thiensville Police Department of failure to maintain abstinence from alcohol, work reports which raised concerns and termination of employment, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

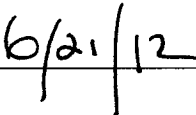
