On September 5, 2012, the Dentistry Examining Board considered information indicating non-compliance by Blair D. Moldenhauer, D.D.S., with previous Orders of the Board dated November 5, 2008 and January 9, 2002. Based upon the information of record, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stay of suspension of the license of Blair D. Moldenhauer, D.D.S., (#3331-15) is hereby **REMOVED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Moldenhauer shall provide a complete list of all of his prescribed medications, over-the-counter medications, and supplements, with dosages, for the twelve (12) months immediately preceding the date of this Order, and shall notify the Department Monitor of any future changes within thirty (30) days of the change.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Moldenhauer shall be subject to random, observed, urine screens at a frequency of ninety-six (96) times per year.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Moldenhauer shall participate in individual and/or group therapy sessions not less than one (1) time per week and shall undergo a full AODA assessment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dr. Moldenhauer shall comply with all other terms and conditions of the Board's Orders dated January 9, 2002 and November 5, 2008, not modified herein. Dr. Moldenhauer shall not petition the Board for a stay and/or modifications to this Order until he has been in full compliance with this Order for six (6) consecutive months.

Any petition for a stay and/or modifications to this Order shall only be considered when accompanied by a written recommendation from Dr. Moldenhauer's therapist expressly supporting Dr. Moldenhauer's petition.
