ORDER

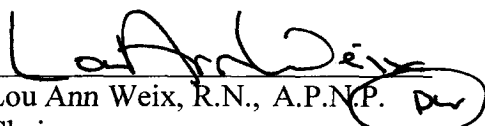
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the return of full licensure status of the registered nurse license of Anita Jones (# 126154-30) is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Anita Jones shall submit a comprehensive psychological and fitness to practice evaluation and testing to be completed by a Board approved psychologist or psychiatrist.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the drug screen frequency shall be reduced to at least fourteen (14) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test.
