On September 13, 2012, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for reinstatement of her revoked license pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated June 9, 2005. Based upon the information of record which shows insufficient evidence of her rehabilitation and fitness to practice, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that request for reinstatement of the registered nurse license of Kari Gyldenvand (#120127-30) is DENIED.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner shall submit, *at the time of petitioning*, the following documents:

- a current AODA assessment by a Board pre-approved provider;
- a current comprehensive psychological evaluation by a Board pre-approved psychologist;
- a list of all current prescriptions from her prescribing physician(s);
- a prescription log from all pharmacies used to fulfill the prescriptions; and
- a current three month AA/NA attendance log.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner shall participate in an approved drug monitoring program with a testing frequency of at least forty-eight (48) urine tests per year and one (1) annual hair test.
