On May 16, 2011, Jene VanDenHout and his attorney appeared before the Medical Examining Board in support of his request for a stay of suspension and modifications to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated September 14, 2005 to decrease the frequency of therapy and drug screens, and terminate the requirement that he appear annually before the Board. Based upon the information of record which shows compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED Jene VanDenHout is GRANTED a STAY of suspension. The stay is continuous contingent upon his compliance with the terms and conditions of his Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request for modification of the limitations on the respiratory care practitioner license of Jene VanDenHout (#1504) to decrease the frequency of drug screens is GRANTED. The frequency of drug screens shall be at least twenty-eight (28) times per year.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. VanDenHout is no longer required to make an appearance before the Board on an annual basis.
