On January 26, 2012, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for modification to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated June 21, 2007 to decrease the frequency of drug screens and to remove the prohibition on pool nursing as a work setting. 
ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modification of the limitations on the registered nurse license of Christine R. Bohl, R.N. (#34002-30) to remove the prohibition on pool nursing is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to reduce the frequency of drug screens is DENIED based on granting Ms. Bohl the ability to work in a pool nursing setting.
