On November 1, 2012, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for full licensure or request for a reduction in drug screens frequency pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated June 21, 2007. 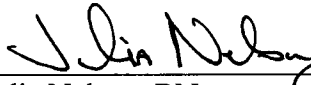
ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for return to full licensure status and the request for reduction of the random drug screens frequency of Christine R. Bohl, L.P.N. (#34002-31) are hereby DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Christine R. Bohl, L.P.N. shall submit to the Department Monitor: all of her current prescriptions; treatment records; and a detailed statement from her prescribing physician regarding her medical care and the medical reasons for the prescription for Methadone or any other prescriptions.
