On October 17, 2007, the Medical Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order indefinitely suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin (#41388-20). The Board subsequently granted a stay of suspension, permitting Respondent to practice under a limited license with certain terms and conditions.



On November 14, 2012, the Board considered Respondent's petition for the return of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Respondent has been fully compliant with the terms and conditions imposed, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's request for the return of full licensure be, and hereby is, GRANTED. Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin (#41388-20) shall now be fully reinstated with all encumbrances, restrictions and limitations removed.
