On March 19, 2008, the Medical Examining Board (Board) issued a Final Decision and Order suspending Bradley J. Schingen's license to practice respiratory care, but immediately stayed the suspension subject to compliance with certain requirements. The requirements included individual and/or group therapy sessions. On May 18, 2009, the Board reduced the petitioner's required therapy sessions to once every other week.

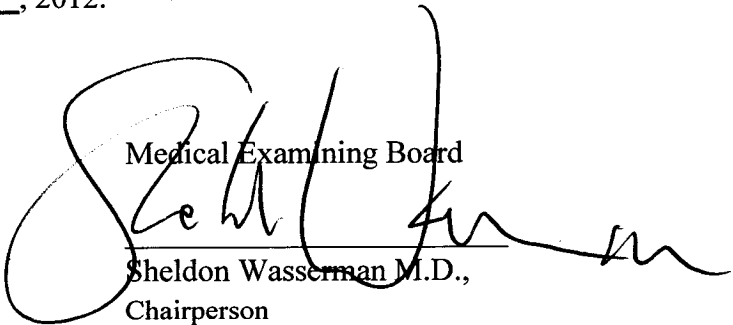
