On July 19, 2012, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for modifications to the limitations on his registered nurse license pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated May 14, 2010 to remove all restrictions on his license or in the alternative remove the restriction which prohibits access to controlled substances for purpose of medication administration to patients in the workplace. Based upon the information of record which shows failure to comply with the drug and alcohol monitoring program due to missed calls, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modifications of the limitations on the registered nurse license of Timothy Murphy (#133915-30) to remove all restrictions on his license is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to allow access to controlled substances in the workplace is DENIED.


