On July 8, 2008, the Department of Safety and Professional Services ordered Respondent's license to be limited as follows: (a) no private detective agency may be issued a firearms permit for Duane R. Peterke; and (b) Duane R. Peterke may not carry on, about or near his person any firearm while working as a private detective, to specifically include a prohibition against (i) carrying a firearm in any vehicle used by him while working as a private detective, and (ii) storing any firearm in any room used by any private detective agency, for any purpose for a period of fifteen (15) months from the date of signing of this Order.

Information has been received by the Department Monitor that the Respondent has completed the time period and complied with the other terms of his Order. A review of department records shows that no new complaints have been filed against Mr. Peterke. A review of court records shows that Mr. Peterke has not been convicted of a misdemeanor since the date of the Order.

Mr. Peterke has petitioned to have the limitations on his personal license (#10733-63) removed.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for full licensure of the private detective license of Duane R. Peterke (license # 10733-63) is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all limitations and encumbrances upon the license of Duane R. Peterke are hereby removed.
