On September 28, 2011, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter, revoking Respondent's license to practice as a dentist in Wisconsin, and forbidding him from petitioning for reinstatement of his license for at least two years from the date of the Order. By its authority under s. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the Dentistry Board also ordered that Respondent pay the costs of this proceeding. On or about July 21, 2010, the Board received an affidavit of costs in the amount of \$ 26,297.68 filed by the prosecuting attorney, James E. Polewski. On or about August 9, 2010, the Board received an affidavit of costs in the amount of \$ 3,260.45 filed by Administrative Law Judge Robert G. Pultz of the Department of Administration, Division of Hearings and Appeals. The Dentistry Board has considered the affidavits of costs, and orders as follows:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding in the combined amount of \$ 29,558.13, as set forth in the affidavits of costs of Attorney James E. Polewski and Administrative Law Judge Robert G. Pultz, which are attached hereto and incorporated by reference, are assessed against Respondent. **Failure to pay the full amount assessed within 90 days of the date of this Order shall constitute a violation of the Order unless Respondent petitions for, and the Department grants, a different deadline.** Under sec. 440.22 (3), Wis. Stats., the Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew, or otherwise issue any credential to Respondent until he has paid the full amount assessed.
