On June 1, 2009, the Barbering and Cosmetology Board ordered Respondents to pay Costs in the amount of \$500.00 and a forfeiture of \$1,100.00 within 150 days from the date of the Order. On May 24, 2011, the Board suspended the license of Cornell Stallworth and D'Zire until such time as the order was complied with. On July 7, 2011, in response to the Respondents' petition for a stay of suspension, the Board granted the stays and ordered 12 equal payment starting July, 2011 and continuing until the obligation was completed.

Information has been received by the Department Monitor that Respondents are in violation of the Order by failing to pay all the costs and forfeiture within the time limit. One payment of \$300.00 has been received. Interest has accrued on the remaining Costs, making \$815.06 due as of the date of this order (Wis. Stat. § 440.22(2).)

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondents' Barber and Cosmetology licenses (#28652 -81 & 33711-80) are SUSPENDED until Respondents have complied with payment of costs and forfeiture under the Order.

This Order is effective five days from the date it is signed.
