#### PROCEDURAL HISTORY

- 1. On February 2, 2009, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board reprimanded Respondents Nga Tuyet Vu (license # 86-1431), Quy Tung (license # 85-5458), and Super Nails & Spa (license #'s 71-2081, 69-529), and ordered them to pay, jointly and severally, a forfeiture of \$8,300.00. The Board further ordered Respondents to pay, jointly and severally, costs of the proceeding in the amount of \$2,600.00.
- 2. The Board stayed \$3,000.00 of the forfeiture amount. The stay was to remain in effect as long as the Respondents were not discovered to allow unlicensed manicurists activity or the use of MMA in the salon. The Order further provided that if the respondents violated the above provisions, the stay would be immediately lifted and full payment of the \$3,000 would be due and payable within thirty days after such unlicensed activity or the use of MMA was discovered by the Department.
- 3. On September 12, 2011, Respondent Nga Tuyet Vu, known as Tina Vu, the owner of Super Nails & Spa, admitted to having allowed unlicensed personnel work in at the salon during the months of January and February 2011 in direct contravention of the Board's Order.
- 4. On October 11, 2011, the Division of Enforcement Department Monitor mailed notification to Respondents informing them that the stay of \$3,000 of the forfeiture was no longer in effect, and demanded payment in full thereof by no later than November 10, 2011.
- 5. On November 3, 2011, in response to the notification and demand for payment from the Department Monitor, the Respondents submitted a request for a payment plan.

Pursuant to the Respondents' request, the Board reviewed this matter at its January 30, 2012 meeting. Based upon the record presented, the Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board makes the following:

### **ORDER**

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Respondents' request for a payment plan is GRANTED as follows:

- 1. Nga Tuyet Vu (license # 86-1431), Quy Tung (license # 85-5458), and Super Nails & Spa (license #'s 71-2081, 69-529) shall, within 30 days of the date of this Order, make a payment of not less than \$400.00. Payments in the amount of \$260.00 shall be made monthly thereafter until the total amount of the fines and costs assessed against the Respondents has been paid.
- 2. Payment of forfeitures and costs shall be made using certified funds (cashier's check, money order or certified check) payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to:

- Any missed payments will be grounds for immediate suspension without further order of the Board.
- 4. All provisions of the February 2, 2009 Order not otherwise modified herein shall remain in full force and effect.

The Board will not consider any requests to modify the conditions of this or its February 2, 2009 Orders before the expiration of six months from the date of this Order.
