By Order dated April 6, 2009, the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board (now, the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board) ordered Respondents to pay costs of the proceedings (costs) of five hundred (\$500) dollars. The Respondents were to make payments in installments of one hundred twenty five dollars (\$125) per quarter, with payments due on June 1, 2009, September 1, 2009, December 1, 2009 and March 1, 2009.

According to records maintained by the Department of Safety and Professional Services, the Respondents have failed to make any payments.

Pursuant to the terms of the April 6, 2009 Order, failure to make the payment as required constitutes a violation of the Order and may result in suspension of the Respondents' licenses without further notice or hearing.

Based upon the entire record in the above-captioned matter, the Board makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that April D. Owens' manager license (#29667-81) is SUSPENDED until she has complied with payment of costs as set forth in the April 6, 2009 Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Aprils Touch of Class establishment license (#29884-80) is SUSPENDED until it has complied with payment of costs as set forth in the April 6, 2009 Order.

This Order is effective five (5) days from the date hereof.
