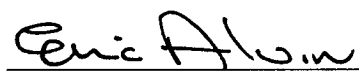
ORDER

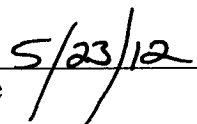
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request to terminate the suspension of the advanced practice social work license of Bradley W. Knapp (license # 474-121) is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Knapp shall arrange for the submission of a report from Dr. James Gerndt regarding Mr. Knapp's ability to practice with reasonable skill and safety of clients and public and does not suffer from any condition which prevents him from practicing in that manner, including recommendations regarding appropriate social work employment settings, if any.
