
On March 22, 2012, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for modifications to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated May 7, 2009 to have access to controlled substances in the course of her nursing practice, remove the work setting restrictions and to reduce the frequency of her drug screens. Based upon the information of record which shows insufficient time under the Order to warrant the modifications and missed call-ins with the drug monitoring program, the Board now finds and makes the following:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modifications of the limitations on the registered nurse license of Megan Frohmader (#149909-30) to have access to controlled substances in the course of her nursing practice, remove the work setting restrictions and reduce the frequency of drug screens is DENIED.
