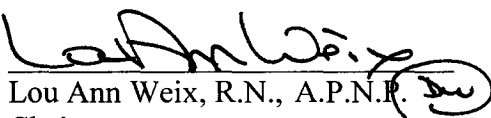

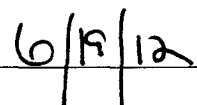
ORDER
