On November 1, 2012, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for full licensure and for the modifications to decrease the frequency of drug screens, to terminate AA/NA verification requirement and to terminate therapy requirement pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated August 9, 2010. Based upon the information of record which shows insufficient length of time in compliance with the terms and conditions under the order, the Board now finds and makes the following:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request to return to full licensure status of the registered nurse license of Elizabeth Forward (#112040-30) is DENIED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the petitioner's request for modification of the limitations to decrease the frequency of drug screens, to terminate AA/NA verification requirement and to terminate therapy requirement is DENIED.
