On October 31, 2012, the Pharmacy Examining Board considered Respondent's request to reduce the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and modify the limitation prohibiting her from working as a pharmacist-in-charge, pursuant to the Final Decision and Order dated September 23, 2009. Based upon the information of record, which shows Respondent's petition was not accompanied by a written request from her managing pharmacist, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens be, and hereby is, GRANTED. Ms. Orth's frequency shall be reduced to no less than 14 per year, plus one annual hair test, until she obtains employment as a pharmacist. When Ms. Orth obtains said employment, the frequency of drug and alcohol screens shall be returned to no less than 48 per year, plus one annual hair test.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Orth's request to work as a pharmacist-in-charge be, and hereby is, DENIED.
