On July 7, 2011, the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board (now, the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board), granted Respondent an initial stay of the suspension of Respondent's manager license, pursuant to the Board Order dated LS 091118484 BAC ("Order"). This Order provided that the stay is continuous contingent upon Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions under the Order.

Information has been received by the Department Monitor that Respondent is in violation of the Board's Order. There is no record of any payments made.

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the stay of suspension is REMOVED and Kathryn P. Short's manager license (#21145-81) is SUSPENDED for an indefinite period.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent may petition the Board for a stay of suspension upon demonstrating, to the satisfaction of the Board or its designee, that Respondent has been in compliance with the provisions this Order.
