
ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modifications of the limitations on the registered nurse license of Karthryn Vander Woude (#92952-30) to decrease the frequency of drug screens is GRANTED. The drug screen frequency shall be at least twenty-eight (28) times per year urine screens and one (1) annual hair test

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Vander Woude shall be in full compliance with the drug screen monitoring program.
