Information submitted in support of Respondent's request for a modification to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated June 3, 2010 to decrease the frequency of drug screens was reviewed on August 29, 2012. Based upon the information of record which shows compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order, the following order is entered:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modification of the limitations on the registered nurse license of Therese A. Schneider (#115967-30) to decrease the frequency of drug screens is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the frequency of drug screens shall be at least fourteen (14) drug screens per year and one (1) annual hair test until such time as Therese A. Schneider obtains nursing employment. At such time the drug screen frequency shall increase to at least forty-eight (48) drug screens per year.

This Order is effective as of August 29, 2012.
