On December 6, 2012, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request that her drug screens be reduced to one per month pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated September 2, 2010. Based upon the information of record which shows Ms. Anderson has had a reduction in the number of drug screens as of April 3, 2012 and has provided abnormal and dilute samples, indicating the need for continuing monitoring, the Board now finds and makes the following:

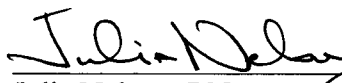
ORDER
