On June 7, 2012, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for modification to the limitation on her license pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated December 2, 2010 to reduce the frequency of drug screens. Based upon the information of record which shows sufficient time under the Order to warrant a drug screen frequency reduction, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modifications of the limitations on the registered nurse license of Vivian Ericson (#128434-30) is GRANTED. The drug screen frequency shall be at least twenty-eight (28) urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
