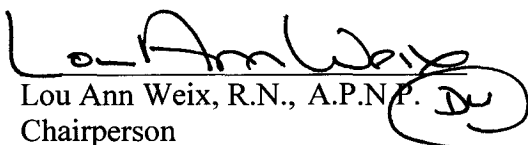
ORDER

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the frequency of drug screens shall be at least twenty-eight (28) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test.
