On November 7, 2012, the Board granted Respondent's request for an extension of time to pay the costs of the proceeding and complete the education required pursuant to the Final Decision and Order dated February 15, 2011. Failure to complete all terms of the Final Decision and Order by the extended deadline, December 1, 2012, shall result in a suspension of Respondent's license without further notice, hearing or action from the Board.


Information received by the Department Monitor demonstrates that Respondent is in violation of the orders dated February 15, 2011 and November 7, 2012 by failing to pay the costs of the proceeding and complete the required education within the allotted time frame.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's license to practice podiatry (#802-25) is hereby SUSPENDED until he has completed all terms of the Final Decision and Order dated February 15, 2011.
