On June 7, 2012, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for return to full licensure status or modification to the limitations imposed pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated March 24, 2011. Based upon the information of record which shows failure to comply with the quarterly work reports requirement of the Order, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the return of full licensure status of the registered nurse license of Wendy Aguirre (# 145200-30) is DENIED.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the request to modify the terms and conditions of the limited license to allow her to work in a home health care, agency or pool setting is DENIED.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Aguirre shall for a period of at least two (2) years arrange for quarterly reports from her nursing employer reporting the terms and conditions of her employment and evaluating her work performance. The two year period shall commence when she gains nursing employment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other terms and conditions in the Final Decision and Order dated March 24, 2011 shall remain in full force and effect.
