On May 3, 2012, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for modification to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated March 24, 2011 to decrease the frequency of drug screens. Based upon the information of record which shows compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order, the Board now finds and makes the following:


ORDER


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modification of the limitations on the registered nurse license of Kelly S. Beers (#146113-30) to decrease the frequency of drug screens is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the frequency of drug screens shall be at least twenty-eight (28) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test until such time as Kelly S. Beers obtains nursing employment. At such time the drug screen frequency shall increase to at least forty-eight (48) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test.
