On May 16, 2011, the Medical Examining Board considered the petitioner's request for modification to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated April 20, 2011 to decrease the frequency of drug screens. NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modification of the limitations on the license to practice medicine and surgery of Dale Thomas Bertram, MD (#25540-20) to decrease the frequency of drug screens is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the frequency of drug screens shall be at least twenty-eight (28) times per year.
