On June 7, 2012, the Board of Nursing considered the petitioner's request for modification of the limitation on her license pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated June 2, 2011 to decrease the frequency of drug screens. Based upon the information of record which shows compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order, the Board now finds and makes the following:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modifications of the limitations on the registered nurse license of Annette Malcomson (#146255-30) is GRANTED. The drug screen frequency shall be at least twenty-eight (28) urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
