
On June 15, 2011, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order reprimanding the license to practice medicine and surgery of Rudy V. Byron, Jr., M.D., (#20-42218). The Board also imposed the following limitations on Dr. Byron's license: he must not prescribe medications over the internet, he must successfully complete the Intensive Course in Controlled Substance Management offered by Case Western Reserve University, and he must not prescribe controlled substances to any patient for a total of more than 30 days in any 365 day period unless and until he completes the Case Western Course. On February 15, 2012, the Board granted Dr. Byron's request for an extension of time to complete the Intensive Course in Controlled Substance Management offered by Case Western Reserve.

Dr. Byron is now requesting removal of all limitations and full reinstatement of his license to practice medicine and surgery. Based on the information of record presented, the Board now finds and makes the following:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request of Rudy V. Byron, M.D., (#20-42218), for full reinstatement of his license be and hereby is, GRANTED.
