By Order dated June 27, 2011, the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board (now, the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board) ordered Respondent to pay costs of the proceeding (costs) in the amount of two hundred seventy dollars (\$270) and a forfeiture of five hundred dollars (\$500). The Respondent was to make the first payment of costs within sixty days following the date of the Order and payment of the forfeiture in installments of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) every 60 days from the date of the previous payment due date until the entire amount was paid in full.

According to records maintained by the Department of Safety and Professional Services, the Respondent has paid the costs. There is no record of any payments toward the forfeiture.

Pursuant to the terms of the June 27, 2011 Order, failure to make the payment as required constitutes a violation of the Order and may result in suspension of the Respondent's licensee without further notice or hearing.

Based upon the entire record in the above-captioned matter, the Board makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Shannon K. Lund's practitioner license (#87790-82) is SUSPENDED until she has complied with payment of forfeitures as set forth in the June 27, 2011 Order.

This Order is effective five (5) days from the date hereof.
