BACKGROUND

On August 17, 2011, the Medical Examining Board (Board) issued a Final Decision and Order reprimanding Dr. John W. Ingalls (31328-20) and limiting his license to practice medicine and surgery. The limitations imposed required the Dr. Ingalls to complete continuing education, have a professional mentor, and refrain from prescribing opioids, including tramadol to any patient for a total of more than 30 days in any 365 day period.

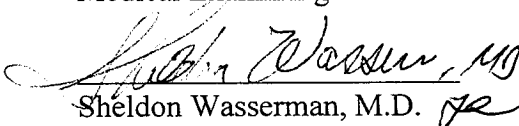
On or about August of 2012, Dr. Ingalls petitioned the Board for full reinstatement of his license. Having provided proof that he has completed the necessary course work, and has been under the supervision of a professional mentor and based upon the information of record, the Board now finds and makes the following:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request to remove all restrictions and reinstate the license to practice medicine and surgery of John W. Ingalls, M.D., (31328-20) be, and hereby is, GRANTED.
